

The global aviation industry has taken leadership on climate change, with a robust plan to reduce emissions based on a comprehensive set of goals. After 2020, technological, infrastructure, and operational efficiency measures will be complemented by the ICAO Carbon Offsetting and Reduction Scheme for International Aviation – better known as “CORSIA”.

The ICAO Standards and Recommended Practices (SARPs) for CORSIA were recently adopted and IBAC has been working closely with IBAC member associations, the Air Transport Action Group (ATAG), and the International Air Transport Association (IATA) to prepare operators for obligations that begin in January 2019 to document and form a baseline for CO2 emissions on all international flights. We encourage all international business aircraft operators to consult the IBAC Web page on CORSIA and, if covered, to attend one of the remaining workshops listed to understand this new global system and how to complete and submit an emissions monitoring plan.

IBAC is coordinating with IATA (International Air Transport Association) to participate in numerous workshops in 2018 as well as participating in several discussions to help educate the business aviation industry on this upcoming CORSIA programme.
